- **Shirt:** Black, grey or white. Polo or button down
- **Pants/Skirts/Skorts/Shorts:** Solid khaki or black
- **Shoes:** Closed toe shoes. Solid black shoes for performances. No slippers, sandals, crocs, or open toe shoes.
- Pace scholars may wear team/school spirit shirt with jeans on Friday's.

- **Shirt:** white, maroon, or grey. Polo or button down
- **Pants/Skirts/Skorts/Shorts:** Solid khaki or black (no sweatpants, gym shorts, or denim)
- **Hoodies/Jacket/Sweater:** maroon, black, white, or gray
- **Shoes:** Closed toe shoes. No slippers, sandals, crocs, or open toe shoes.
- **No hats, scarves, head wraps or spikes/chains, or visible underwear.**
