The goal of mobile crisis is to respond to people in the community during their time of need in hopes of decreasing the need for Law Enforcement/EMS involvement, Emergency Department visits, and acute psychiatric hospitalizations. By supporting the person in the community where they are, we can provide additional support and education to help keep them safe

How to access:

What to expect:

- The person receiving the initial call will seek and gather info regarding the person/persons involved and the presenting issues
- Will assess the safety of the situation
- Will determine if a mobile deployment is available and appropriate
