Many of our younger students have also celebrated significant milestones as they advance from their elementary schools or Finley Middle School. All of our students are successfully progressing to the next stages of their educational journeys.

As we move into the summer, construction of new classrooms at Landing School is progressing rapidly with an anticipated completion date of December 2024. Additionally, construction of new classrooms and the elevator at Deasy School is advancing with an anticipated completion date of Summer 2025.
