

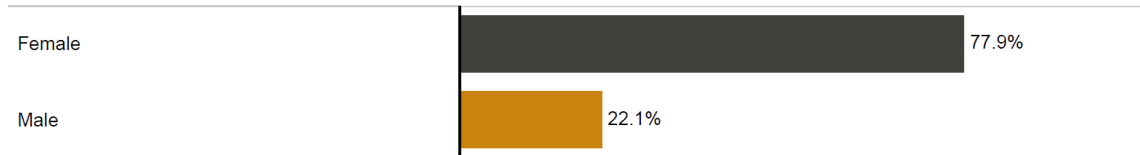
1/9 Strategic Planning Committee Meeting Data/Would Like More Information Questions

1. Panorama data: Is disaggregated by demographics available? **Panorama data can be disaggregated by demographics.** Is there pre & post pandemic data available? **No, last year was the first Panorama survey.** Do we know who opted out? **Yes, approximately 70% of secondary students took the survey and 75% elementary students took the survey this last survey. We do have the capability of looking in the system to see if a student took the test or not.**
2. How are 9th grade graduation rates being projected? **I am not clear on this question. On the OSPI report card the graduation rate for the district was 88.9%. The 9th grade on track to graduate was 81.8% students. The schools do many things between the Freshman to Senior year to help students graduate like credit recovery, dual credit classes, AP testing,**
3. How are “special needs” defined? **Students found to be eligible for specialty designed instruction and related services according to the WA State administrative code and then provided services through an IEP.**
4. OSPI data had foster care listed as 0%, but there are students in this category – is this data available at the district level? Same for homeless students – is there district level data available that is different than OSPI’s? **The district has 87 McKinney Vento student (4 in motels, 1 in a shelter, 2 unsheltered, 80 that live with family or friends), and 5 foster kids.**
5. Who opted out of Zoom for Apex? **The numbers we have are 198 students took APEX classes first semester of 2020 and 78 second semester. Some of these students were also in Zoom though and took APEX classes in addition to their regular Zoom classes in order to gain additional credits.**
6. How is the “Mobile” student category defined? **According to the state, a mobile student is defined as students with less than 150 total calendar days of enrollment during the school year (mostly kids that move part way through the year).**
7. Can data points with percentages also include the numbers associated with them? **No, the percentages provided came from OSPI.**

9. How representative are the staff of the students/families in the district? **Please see attached OSPI data.**

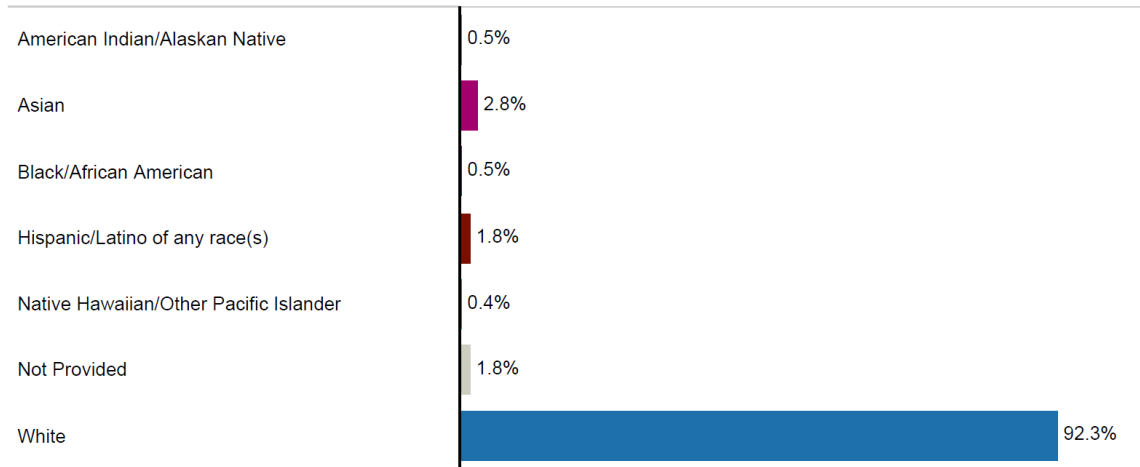
OSPI Staff demographics

Snohomish School District 2021-22

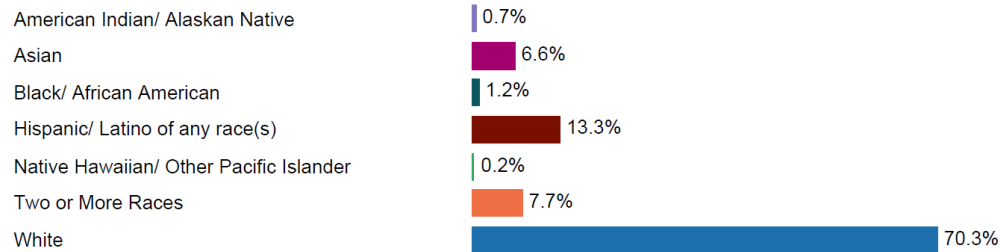
Total Student Enrollment
