NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The **Floyd County Board of Education** has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by **<u>6.92</u>** percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at Floyd County Board of Education, 600 Riverside Parkway, Rome, GA 30161 on July 17, 2023 at 7:30 am.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at Floyd County Board of Education, 600 Riverside Parkway, Rome, GA 30161 on <u>July 24,</u> <u>2023 at 11:30 am and 6:00 pm</u>.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of <u>17.700 mills</u>, an increase of <u>1.146 mills</u>. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than <u>16.554 mills</u>. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of <u>\$200,000</u> is approximately <u>\$89.39</u> and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of <u>\$200,000</u> is approximately <u>\$91.68</u>.

PRESS RELEASE ANNOUNCING A PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Floyd County Board of Education today announces its intention for the 2023 millage rate to decrease from 17.950 mills to 17.700 mills. However, due to reassessments this will result in an increase of 6.92 percent over the rollback millage rate described below.

Each year, the board of tax assessors is required to review the assessed value for property tax purposes of taxable property in the county. When the trend of prices on properties that have recently sold in the county indicate there has been an increase in the fair market value of any specific property, the board of tax assessors is required by law to re-determine the value of such property and adjust the assessment. This is called a reassessment.

When the total digest of taxable property is prepared, Georgia law requires that a rollback millage rate must be computed that will produce the same total revenue on the current year's digest that last year's millage rate would have produced had no reassessments occurred.

Before the Floyd County Board of Education may finalize a tentative budget and set a final millage rate, Georgia law requires three public hearings to be held to allow the public an opportunity to express their opinions on the increase.
