



NSBHS Off-Campus Lunch (2024-2025)

10th – 12th grade students are eligible to participate in off-campus lunch during the 1st Grading Period if they have **met the following criteria:**

Quarter 1 (2024-2025) Off-Campus Lunch Eligibility

- Student has earned the appropriate credits & is classified as 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
- Student has a 2024-2025 NSBHS Student ID
- Student & Parent have completed & turned in the off-campus lunch permission form to Ms. Roberts, Activities Director (2-116) (completed **each** quarter) – **Permission slip is located on the back of this document.**
- Student has paid the \$10.00 fee for the quarterly off-campus lunch sticker online through the PARENT PORTAL
- Without the student ID and proper Off campus sticker, students will not be permitted to leave campus.

How Can I Get My Sticker?

- **Eligible students** may purchase their Quarterly off-campus lunch sticker on-line through the Parent Portal Account.
- To obtain the Off Campus Lunch Sticker, students must provide their signed permission form, 2024-2025 Student ID and their receipt of off campus lunch sticker payment from Parent Portal. With all documents, students may obtain the sticker at the Activities Office (2-116) before school, during lunch or after school.
- **Students MUST have their 2024-2025 NSBHS school ID to purchase the Off-Campus Lunch Sticker**
- **REPLACEMENT STICKERS WILL NOT BE SOLD**

Off-Campus Lunch Procedures

- **The date students may begin Off-Campus Lunch is TBD & will be announced during the first week of school. All students must attend their in-school grade-level meeting before going off-campus.**
- **Until Off-Campus Lunch begins, students must bring a lunch or get lunch from the cafeteria.**

Students must adhere to the below procedures to retain the off-campus lunch privilege –

- **Students may only go off-campus during their lunch period & return on time for 5^h period to retain the privilege.**
- Students may not return with food to consume in the next class period.
- Must exit/enter through the doors between the Counseling office and building 1(Main office)
- Must show ID & sticker to Campus Advisor, Administrator and/or NSBHS faculty/staff daily.
- Students without the ID & sticker will not be allowed off-campus for the day.
- Must not transport undergraduate & students without permission to be off campus.
- Be on time for fifth period (not tardy to class). Students arriving late to class (or skipping) will lose the off-campus lunch privilege. Students who lose the privilege will not be given a refund.

- Student has earned an UNWEIGHTED *Previous* Grading Period GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Student has NO Grades of D or F from the *Previous* Grading Period
