



2024 - 2025 Dress Code

A uniform dress code is required of all Swift School students. **The Lab** is the exclusive provider of our school uniform.

- Students are required to wear Swift School polo shirts (long and short-sleeved) with the official Swift logo embroidered on the garment. The Lab sells polos in white, gray, navy blue, and sky blue. **Please note that polos previously purchased at Lands' End are acceptable for 2024-25.**
- For 2024-25, jumpers previously purchased through Lands' End with the Swift logo are acceptable. Jumpers must be worn no shorter than two inches above the knee. A school-approved polo shirt should be worn under the jumper.
- Slacks, shorts, and skorts can be purchased from any store and must be khaki or navy. Cargo and form-fitting bottoms are not permitted.
- Skirts and skorts must be worn no shorter than two inches above the knee.
- Solid-color leggings (white, blue, navy) may be worn under skirts and jumpers.
- Clothing is not permitted to be undersized or oversized.
- Hoodies and Sweatshirts purchased through The Lab may be worn in the classroom with a uniform shirt underneath.
- Tennis shoes must be worn every day. Sneakers with wheels, lights, etc. are prohibited.
- Hats are not permitted to be worn in school during the academic day.

PE Uniform - Grades 6th-8th only:

PE uniforms can be ordered through The Lab. The PE uniform consists of the sky blue long or short sleeve spirit wear t-shirt (required) and gray shorts with a wicker lining. Both pieces are required for PE. **For 2024-25, PE uniforms that were previously purchased through Lands' End are acceptable.**

Lower Division (Grades K-4) Approved Spirit Wear-Friday only:

- Swift Spirit wear t-shirts may be worn on Friday. This also includes t-shirts from the Dyslexia Dash or other school-sponsored events.
- Students need to wear khaki or navy bottoms.
- Sneakers must be worn.

Middle Division (Grades 5-8) Fridays only:

- Students may earn out-of-uniform days (most Fridays). On these days, clothing must be school-appropriate.
