



RELEASE OF STUDENT DATA NOTICE TO PARENTS OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS – MILITARY RECRUITMENT

In Saint Paul Public Schools, the following information about students is public:

- Name
- Birth Date
- Grade
- School
- Dates of Enrollment
- Awards Received
- Extracurricular Information (including height and weight of athletes)

Both the Minnesota Legislature and the United States Congress have passed laws requiring us to also release addresses, telephone numbers, and email addresses of students in high school to military recruiters. Under those laws, you also have the option of refusing to release this information regarding yourself and your student. If you do not want Saint Paul Public Schools to release information about yourself and your student to military recruiters, please fill out the form below and return it to your student’s school. **The parent/guardian or student who has reached the age of 18 may choose not to release information to military recruiters. That choice will remain in effect until the parent/guardian or student who has reached the age of 18 submits a written request to the school allowing the release of information to military recruiters.**
