- Large zippered pencil bag or plastic tool box, to hold desk supplies
- Two-pocket folders, preferable plastic: 1 Writing (purple), 1 ELA (blue), 1 Math (red), 1 Science (green), 1 Social Studies (orange), 1 Work (yellow), 1 Choice Board (black), and 2 additional folders (choose your design) standard size (no bigger than 9 ½ x 11 ½)
- sturdy ruler with both inches and centimeters (<u>not</u> bendable)
- 24 count box of crayons
- 12 pack of colored pencils (already sharpened please)
- 1 DRY-ERASE marker (color doesn't matter)
- 2 black sharpie markers fine point
- 2 yellow or orange highlighters
- small, handheld pencil sharpener (make sure it catches its own shavings)
- 3 dozen #2 wooden pencils (sharpened)
- Art Sketchbook (9"x12", blank paper, ring bound)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- Ear buds/headphones (labeled with name)
- If possible, any amount of Paper Mate Arrowhead Cap Erasers would be greatly appreciated! These particular cap erasers are very sturdy and are less likely to break.
