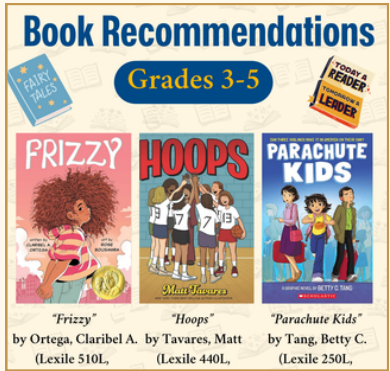
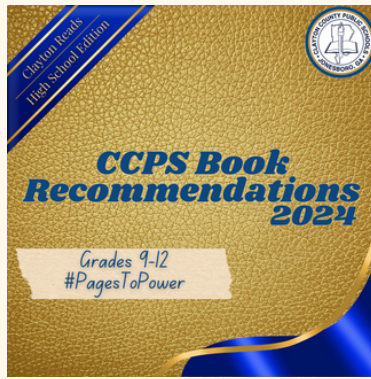
The Clayton County Public Library provides access to "TumbleBook Library", a collection of hundreds of ebooks including animated picture books, read-along chapter books, videos, and more.

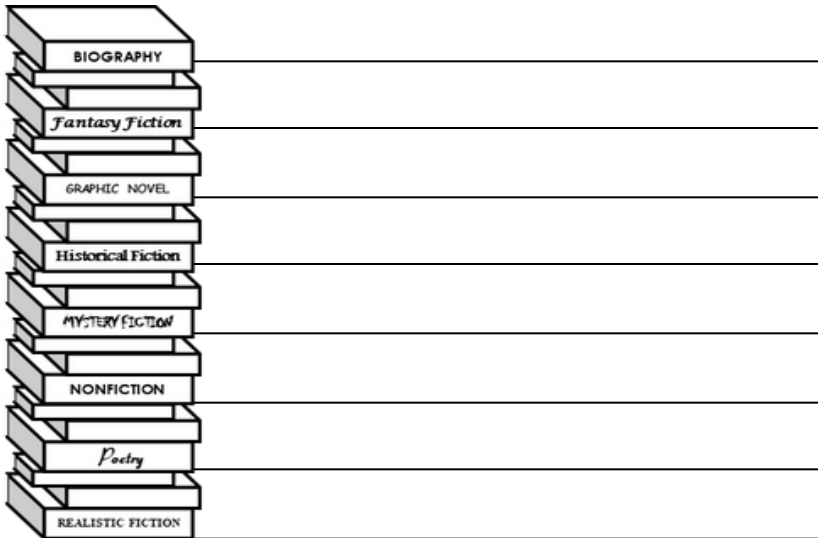

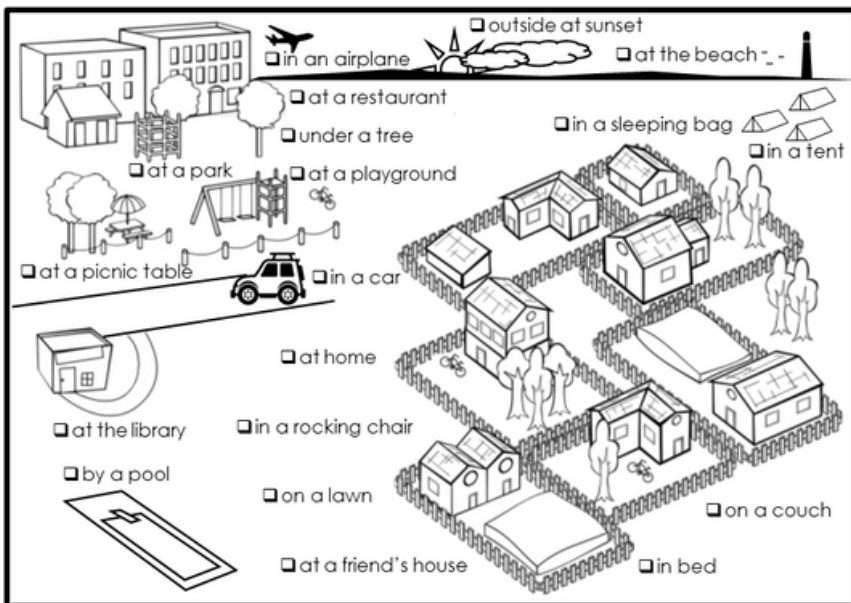
How Long Can You Read?
