ATHLETIC CLEARANCE FORMS

What forms are required in order to participate in athletics?

REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN FOR THE 2024-25 SCHOOL YEAR

Athletic clearance forms will need to be completed via Snap! Registration in order to participate; this includes emailing the physical exam forms to the Health Office. These should be completed prior to the first scheduled tryout date. To access and submit all requisite documents, please see below:

- Parents/Guardians must log in to their <u>Snap!</u>
 <u>Registration</u> account.
 - New users will need to <u>create an account</u> if they do not already have one.
 - Students CANNOT register themselves; if a student email is used and/or student contact information, the registration will be marked as incomplete.
- Students who are not enrolled at Granada Hills Charter (those who do not have a GHC Student ID number) MAY NOT register for sports.

Two step process! SNAP and PHYSICAL

How to Register with SNAP:

- Visit: Go to the GHC Athletics Page and click on the SNAP REGISTRATION link.
- 2. **Create Account:** Follow simple steps to create your profile.Click the **How to Complete Registration** link on the GHC Webpage for a how to video.
- 3. Choose Your Sport: Browse through available sports and select yours.
- 4. **Complete Forms:** Fill out necessary information securely.
- 5. **Submit:** Click submit and you're all set!

How to clear a physical:

- You must use our form from the Health Office (can be found under Athletic Clearance Forms)
- 2. The completed form is then mailed to the **Health Office** (email address can be found under Athletic Clearance Forms)
- 3. Forms must be emailed **AT LEAST ONE WEEK** prior to tryout

Graduation Requirements

A minimum of 230 credits of required classes are needed to graduate!

What? 230 Credits?

- Attend and pass the STA
- 140 minimum credits of "a-g"
- 5 credits of Government
- 5 credits of Economics
- 10 credits of a Local Option
- 20 credits of PE Includes Health
 - GHC approved interscholastic athletics meet this requirement
- 50-70 high school electives



A-G Requirements are College Entry Requirements

- A. 3 years of Social Science
- B. 4 years of English
- C. 3 years of college prep math; 4 years is better
- D. 2 years of Lab Science; 3 to 4 years is better
- E. 2 years of World Languages; 3-4 years is best
- F. 1 year of Visual and Performing Arts
- G. 1 year College Prep Elective

The good news!



When your student graduates from GHC with Cs or better in all of their a-g classes, they will meet the minimum eligibility requirements for most 4 year universities (i.e. UC/CSU & Private Universities)

- During STA all students are given a Scoir account.
- SCOIR is our College and Career Platform.
 - College searches, career profiles, resume builders, event registrations (i.e. college representatives).
- Students will meet our college counselors this Thursday and Friday!
- Many GHC students take a combination of AP, IB, Honors, CP and college courses classes for the best college resume!






CANVAS Learning Management System












Where can you and your student get help?
