

Year 10 Curriculum Overview: German

Rationale: Students follow the Pearson Edexcel GCSE course.. They will develop their skills from KS3 to speak and write about the thematic concepts in three tenses, with Higher tier students able to use a further two tenses. They will widen their vocabulary from KS3 to understand longer reading and listening texts about the thematic concepts.
