








The school uniform for students in years 7-11 is made up of the following:

<p style="text-align: center;">Blazer</p> 	<p>Compulsory – black blazer with KHS crown embroidered on the pocket.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">School Tie</p> 	<p>Compulsory - clip-on tie with student's house colour:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yellow – Verney • Green – Fosse • Red – Castle • Blue - Avon
<p style="text-align: center;">Shirt</p> 	<p>Plain white, collared, long or short sleeved, white polyester or cotton shirt.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Trousers</p> 	<p>Plain black, tailored, polyester or viscose trousers. Should have a plain waistband. Should NOT have flares which extend over the shoe. Should NOT touch or drag on the floor. Should NOT have decorations, bows, adornments, stitched creases or be made of a stretchy, clingy material. Belts, if worn, should be of a conventional narrow type, black, threaded through loops with an unobtrusive buckle.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Skirt</p> 	<p>Plain black, pleated school skirt.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Socks or Tights</p> 	<p>Plain black or white ankle socks or plain black tights.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Shoes</p> 	<p>Plain black (not suede/no logos) traditional school shoes. All footwear must be suitable for the school environment. In the interests of health and safety, high heels, open toe, sling-backs, platforms, canvas, trainers or boots are not permitted for use around school.</p>

The following items are optional additions to the uniform:

Outdoor Coat	Any outdoor coat which is worn should be plain, without graffiti or badges. No denim, leather, suede, or hooded, sweatshirt-type tops/jackets. The purpose of the outer coat is to afford protection from adverse weather conditions, i.e., rain. If pupils are walking or cycling to school, we advise the use of safety armbands or stick-ons.
School Sweater	Plain black, v neck sweater. Full length sleeve and body. Cardigans and cropped sweaters are not permitted.

Other information:

Hairstyles	Students with long hair should tie it back. Extreme and/or exhibitionist hairstyles are not permitted. Hair colour should be within the natural range of shades.
Jewellery	Students are permitted to wear a single stud earring in each ear. No other piercings or items of jewellery are permitted.
Make-up	The use of make-up is not permitted for students.
