

WHAT DO **YELLOW** LIGHTS FLASHING ON A SCHOOL BUS INDICATE?

Yellow flashing lights mean the bus is preparing to stop to load or unload children. Slow down and prepare to stop.

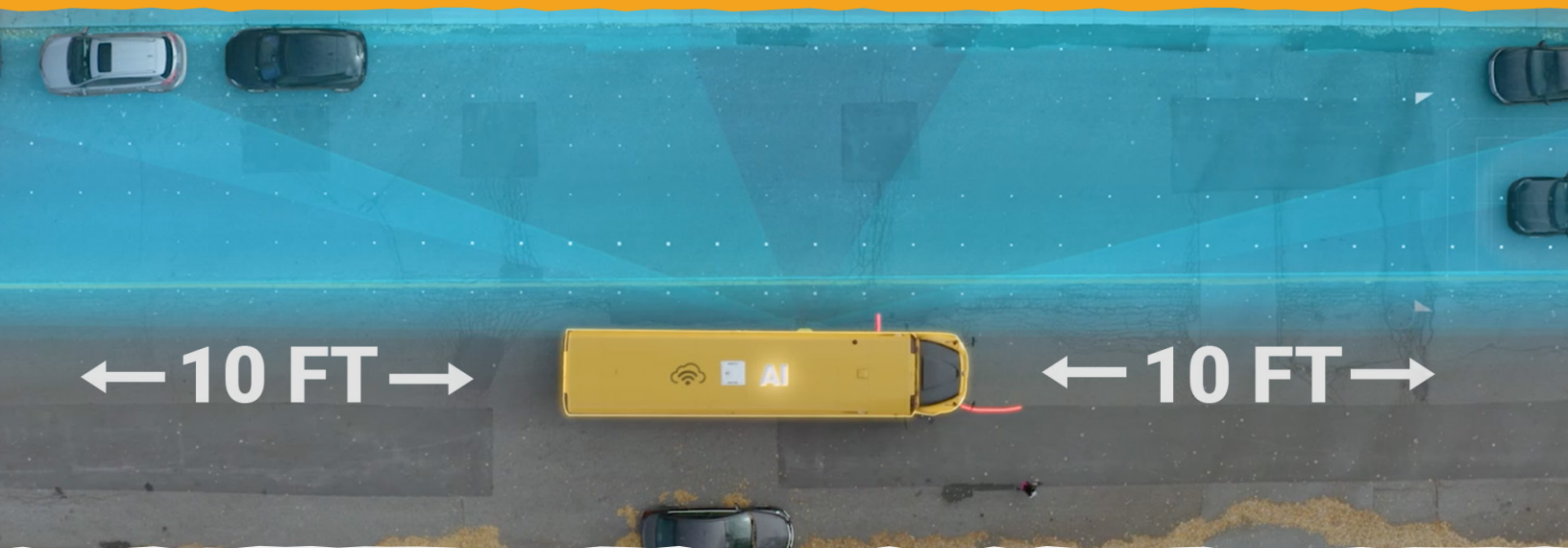

SAFETY TIPS

When a stopped school bus flashes its red light(s) and deploys its stop-arm, motorists that approach from either direction must stop before reaching the bus. You should stop at least 10 feet away from the bus.

WHAT DO **RED** LIGHTS FLASHING ON A SCHOOL BUS INDICATE?

Red flashing lights mean the bus has stopped and children are getting on or off. You cannot drive again until the red lights stop flashing and the stop-arm is retracted.

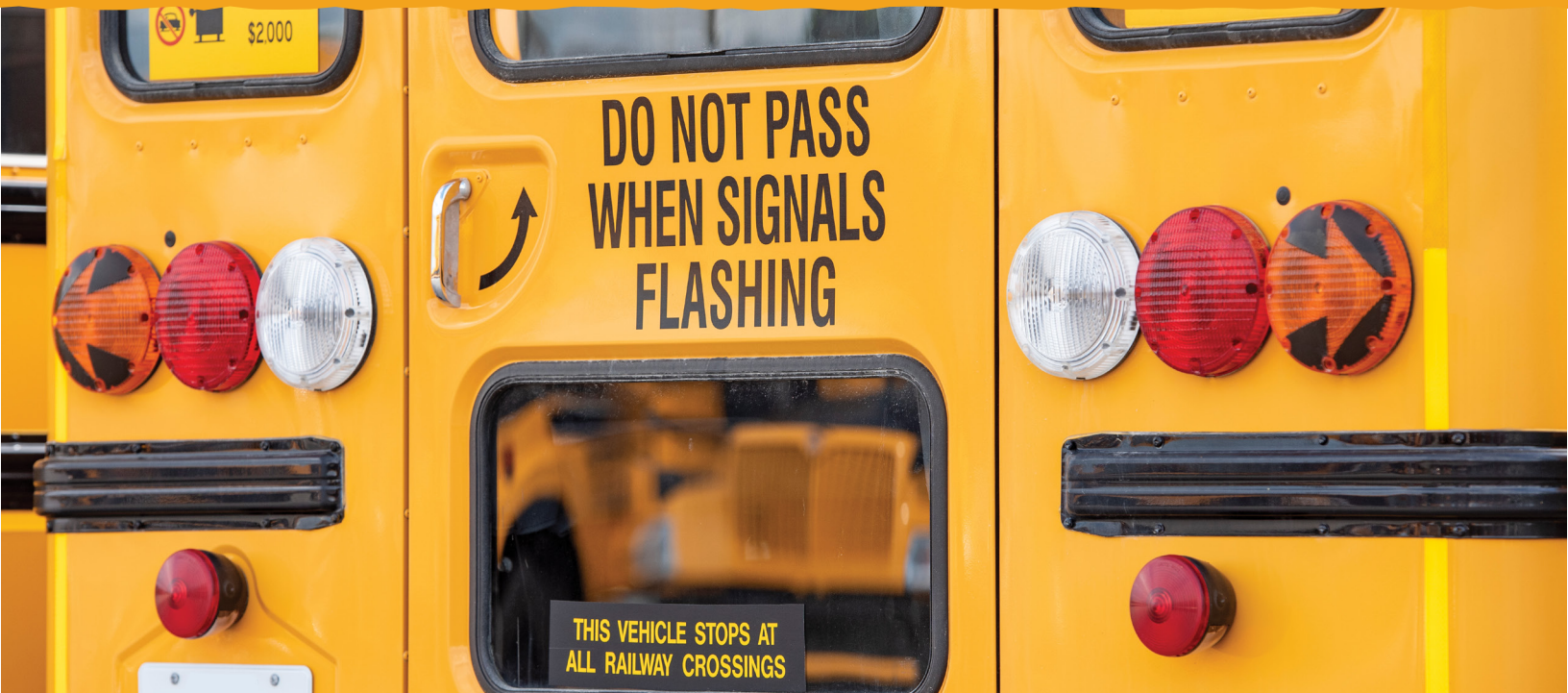

WHEN IS IT SAFE TO PROCEED AFTER STOPPING FOR A SCHOOL BUS?

When you stop for a school bus, you cannot drive again until the red lights stop flashing and the stop-arm is retracted.

SAFETY TIPS

Proceed with extreme caution whenever you see a school bus. Children are most at risk as they step on and off the bus.

DID YOU KNOW?

Stop-arm cameras identify illegal passers by license plate number. Tickets are issued to a vehicle's registered owner.

Violation: \$300

SCHOOL BUS STOPPING LAW CHEAT SHEET

When a school bus stops, flashes its red lights, and deploys its stop-arm, traffic approaching from either direction must stop before reaching the bus:



Drivers may proceed with caution when a physical barrier separates a divided highway.
