

## **High School Supply List by Department**

2024 - 2025

Below, noted by department you will find the specific items teachers are requiring your student to purchase and bring to class on the first day of school.

#### Bible

- **Bible 9 (Furuto)**: Folder for returned materials; blue or black-colored ink pens and red ink pen, highlighter, colored pencils, and #2 pencils; lined and unlined paper. **An ESV Bible to use in class**
- **Bible 9 (Bragan)**: One-inch, loose-leaf, three-ring binder; blue or black-colored ink pens, pencils, and colored pencils; loose-leaf notebook paper.
- **Bible 10:** A fully charged iPad and MacBook Air every day for class. <u>A ESV paper copy Bible to use in class.</u>
- **Bible 11**: One-inch, loose-leaf, three-ring binder, dividers; blue or black-colored ink pens; expo markers; loose-leaf notebook paper; **a physical Bible to use in class**.
- **Bible 12**: Pen or Pencil. A fully charged iPad every day for class. A spiral notebook or binder with loose-leaf paper. **a physical Bible to use in class**.

### **English**

- **English 9**: Pencils, pens (red, blue, and black) folder with pockets, 4x6 note cards, paper clips, highlighters, notebook paper, binder or folder (can be combined with other subjects)
- **Honors English 9:** Pencils, red and black or blue pens, a folder with pockets, 4x6 note cards, a single binder ring, paper clips, highlighters, notebook paper, binder or folder (can be combined with other subjects), Post-it notes (regular square, not the little flag post-its), headphones or earbuds.
- **English 10:** Red pens, pencils, and blue or black pens, a yellow highlighter and one other highlighter of any color, at least one set of 100 index cards, a composition notebook like the old-school Tops brand 9 3/4" x 7 1/2" bound composition notebook, Post-it notes (regular square, not the little flag post-its), loose-leaf notebook paper, three tabbed dividers for a three-ring binder. (Students do not need a separate binder for this class, but do need to be able to access and separate their English homework, notes, and handouts from other classes.)
- Honors English 10: Pencils and blue or black pens, highlighters, a composition notebook, loose-leaf
  notebook paper, three-ring binder. (Students do *not* need a separate binder for my class but do need to be
  able to access and separate their English homework, notes, and handouts from other classes)
- **English 11**: Pencils and pens (black or blue only), 4 highlighters (blue, green, yellow, orange), and a 3-ring binder with loose-leaf paper.
- **Honors English 11:** Pencils and pens (black or blue only), 4 highlighters (blue, green, yellow, orange), and a 3-ring binder with loose-leaf paper.
- **AP Language 11:** Pencils and blue pens, highlighters in 4 colors, a two-pocket folder, notebook paper, and a 1" binder

- **English 12:** Three-ring binder with loose leaf paper, 3 dividers with tabs, pencil, pen (blue or black ink only), and 4 highlighters (blue, green, yellow, & orange).
- **Honors English 12:** Three-ring binder with loose leaf paper, 3 dividers with tabs, pencil, pen (blue or black ink only), and 4 highlighters (blue, green, yellow, & orange).
- **AP English 12:** Three-ring binder with loose leaf paper, 3 dividers with tabs, ink pens (blue or black ink only), a pencil, and 4 highlighters (blue, green, yellow, & orange).
- **Honors English 12 Dual Enrollment:** Paper folder with pockets, post-it notes, highlighters, a three-ring binder (can be shared with another class), and notebook paper.
- **Creative Writing/Artisan:** journal for independent writing (any style based on student preference is fine) and sticky notes.
- **ACT Prep**: Pencil. Red pen. Highlighter. Document folder, calculator, and auxiliary headphones for an online unit.

#### History

- World History 2 (9th Grade) One three-ring binder, college ruled paper, pencils, pens, colored pencils
- US History 1 (10th Grade) Pens (blue or black), pencils, loose-leaf paper, note cards, binder
- Honors U.S. History 1 (10th Grade) Pens, pencils, loose-leaf paper, colored pencils, 1 <u>RED</u> folder with pockets and brads
- **U.S History 2 (11th Grade)** Pens (blue or black), pencils, loose-leaf paper, note cards (3x5 or 4x6), binder, composition book
- Honors U.S. History 2 (11th Grade) Pens, pencils, loose-leaf paper, colored pencils, 1 <u>RED</u> folder with pockets and brads
- **AP U.S. History (11th Grade)** Pens (blue or black), pencils, loose-leaf paper, note cards, binder, 2 composition books
- **Government / Economics (12th Grade)** -Pens(blue or black), loose-leaf paper, notebook with pockets or a binder
- AP US Government / AP Macroeconomics (12th Grade) Pens (blue or black), pencils, loose-leaf paper, note cards, binder

### Math

- **Algebra I:** 1 inch binder, 5 tab binder dividers, Post It Sticky <u>Tabs</u>, pencils with erasers, red pen, 3+ highlighters, small straight edge, College ruled lined paper (with 3 hole punch), 5x5 graph paper (with 3 hole punch), TI -30XIIS scientific calculator (\$10 on Amazon)
- Geometry: Binder, pencils, colored pens, highlighters, 2 dry erase markers, loose-leaf paper, graph paper, TI-84 or TI-84+ Calculator. \*\*Cost of the calculator is approx. \$100, but will be used throughout HS and college\*\*
- **Honors Geometry and Honors Geometry MT:** Binder, pencils, colored pens, highlighters, 2 dry erase markers, loose-leaf paper, graph paper, TI-84 or TI-84+ Calculator. \*\*Cost of the calculator is approx. \$100, but will be used throughout HS and college\*\*
- **Algebra II:** Binder or large folder for handouts and notes, loose-leaf paper, pencils, highlighters, colored pens for corrections, 2-4 dry erase markers, TI-84 or TI-84+ calculator

- **Honors Algebra II and Hon Alg 2 MT:** a 3-ring binder with paper in it (any size), pencils, 4 dry-erase markers, TI-84 or TI-84+ Calculator.
- **PreCalculus:** Binder or large folder for handouts and notes, loose-leaf paper, pencils, highlighters, colored pens, 2-4 dry erase markers, TI-84 or TI-84+ calculator
- Hon Precal, Hon Precal DE, and Hon Precal MT: 1.5 -2 inch binder (or you can use a large section in a binder being used for several classes), loose leaf paper, graph paper, PENCILS, red pens, highlighters, 4 dry erase markers, graph paper, TI-84 or TI-84+ Calculator
- Adv. Algebra w/Finance: Binder or large folder for handouts and notes, loose-leaf paper, pencils, highlighters, colored pens for corrections, 2-4 dry erase markers, TI-84 or TI-84+ calculator
- **Honors and AP Calculus:** Binder or large folder for handouts and notes, loose-leaf paper, pencils, highlighters, colored pens, 2-4 dry erase markers, TI-84 or TI-84+ calculator
- **AP Stats:** Binder, pencils, colored pens, highlighters, 2 dry-erase markers, loose-leaf paper, graph paper, TI-84 or TI-84+ Calculator.
- **AP Computer Science**: 3 ring binder with loose-leaf paper

#### Science

- **Health (independent study for those who did not have it in 8th grade):** poster board, markers.
- **Earth & Space:** 1-inch binder, notebook paper, 3-hole graph paper notebook (for Labs and activities), pencils, pens, dry erase markers, calculator.
- **Conceptual Physics:** One 1.5-inch three-ring binder with pockets, 5 subject dividers, loose leaf paper, graph paper, dry-erase markers, calculator, pencils, pens, highlighters, and index cards.
- **Honors Physics:** Dry-erase markers, ruler, protractor, calculator, dry-erase markers, lab book (composition book), and more dry-erase markers...
- **Chemistry and Honors Chemistry:** At least a 2-inch 3-ring binder with college ruled paper in it (can be used for multiple courses); pencils and blue/black pens; colored pens for corrections (red, green, purple, etc.); a stylus for iPad; dry erase markers; a graphing calculator (TI-84 or TI-84+, the one with batteries, NOT rechargeable, is the most durable and reliable).
- **Biology:** One composition notebook (any color), 2 white standard poster boards, colored pencils, a highlighter, pens, and plenty of pencils.
- **DE Biology:** One composition notebook (any color), colored pencils, highlighter, pens, and plenty of pencils.
- Honors Biology: 3-ring binder, Dry-erase markers, notebook paper and graph paper, colored pens, pencils
- **Human Anatomy & Physiology and Honors Anatomy:** Colored pencils and markers, highlighter, a 2-inch binder filled with college-ruled notebook paper, pens, and pencils. One box of disposable, powdered, gloves for dissections (can be shared between multiple students).
- **AP Chemistry:** 3-ring binder with college-ruled paper in it, pencils, colored pens for corrections (red, green, purple, etc.), a stylus for iPad, dry erase markers, graphing calculator (TI-84 or TI-84 PLUS).
- **AP Physics C**: Binder with notebook paper and graph paper, dry-erase markers, colored pens, pencils, calculator, ruler, and protractor.

- **AP Biology:** One binder with notebook paper and graph paper, expo markers, colored pens, pencils, calculator. Optional: an AP Biology study workbook, available for purchase from the school.
- **AP Environmental Science**: One binder with notebook paper, pencils, and a calculator.

# **World Language**

- **All French Classes:** A folder with w/2 *pockets* for handouts, and tests; stylus for iPad; loose-leaf lined paper; colored pencils; regular pencils; iPad. All students must have earbuds for in class speaking and listening activities.
- **All Spanish Classes:** A notebook for students that want hard copies of work instead of using the iPad and iPad stylus. When using a notebook the student needs *pocket* dividers, lined notebook paper, pens/pencils, colored pens for corrections. All students must have earbuds for in class speaking and listening activities.
