SCHOOL HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING

April 14, 2022

**MINUTES**

**I. Call to Order/Welcome**

Elizabeth Cisneros, Health Service Director, called meeting to order at 1:32 p.m. Mrs. Cisneros welcomed and thanked those in attendance. The meeting was held via Zoom due to lack of available meeting space at both SRHS and Jo Nelson Middle School due to district meet being held at SRISD track and many teachers assisting with event.

**II. Minutes**

The committee reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. There was a correction to the following items: Ms. Alexandra Barba and not Aislinn Hinojosa, ACE, had a suggestion on a curriculum for the Health Human Sexuality Curriculum, and the title for Ms. Candy Wiley, changed from Wesley Methodist Ministries Nurse to Wesley Nurse. San Juanita Garza motioned to accept the minutes; Troy Villarreal second the motion. The minutes were approved with the mentioned corrections.

**III. ACE Updates**

Mr. Troy Villarreal was introduced to the committee as the new ACE Director. He informed the committee of the current number of students they are servicing. They are currently servicing 283 students in all three campuses. Mr. Villarreal also informed the committee of the 100% parent engagement at all three campuses. He informed us of the current vacancies they are needing to fill and the upcoming projects/events planned for the ACE program, such as the 5K Warriors Run/Walk scheduled for April 30, 2022. He thanked those present for their time.

**IV. HB 1525 Updates & COVID/Health Updates**

Mrs. Cisneros informed the committee that on Monday, (4/11/22), Board Meeting the Board issued a resolution to give the SHAC committee the approval to review and recommend Instructional material for the Human Sexuality Curriculum. I informed the committee about a Zoom presentation I attended (ICHAMP), this company has great resources to help with the adoption of curriculum approved and the TEKS that it targets. I shared the link with the committee. The committee voted to have a special committee to continue with additional meetings to adopt the Human Sexuality Curriculum. There were 11 members present and all voted on having a special committee.

Mrs. Cisneros also provided information in regards to COVID. Testing continues to be offered at all three campuses for staff and students. She stated that the request for testing has decreased significantly and that there have been no positive cases at SRISD since March. She also informed us that a Vaccine Clinic was held 4/8/2022 for staff needing to get boosters.

Mrs. Cisneros also informed the committee that students in the middle and high schools had participated in a Tobacco Survey this morning. The survey aims at collecting data on Youth's

point of view for tobacco usage perceived social norms related to smoking, and social influences related to tobacco usage as well as health risks, and quitting history.
