District partnership description: We partnered with the Allen County Educational Service Center to have additional resources for our School Nurse and Guidance to utilize when needed.


Allowable use of funds: Physical Health Care Services

What data will you use to demonstrate successful implementation: All student accidents are logged and notation is made based on care given. These positions have been highly used in the past and we are confident it will continue. The guidance department collects data on graduation rates and helps students prepare for college (with work on FAFSA, financial aid etc.)
