

**Superintendent's PIE Meeting**  
**Thursday, January 4, 2024**  
**11:00 a.m.**  
**Remote Meeting**

Superintendent Crozier opened the meeting at 11:01 a.m. and welcomed all who were present on Zoom.

Updates included:

- Central Office is now moved into the new Fairbank Building. The move went very well without much disruption to service during the transition.
- The SPS FY25 budget was approved by the Sudbury School Committee on December 22, 2023. Next steps include the Finance Committee's budget hearing followed by vote at the annual Sudbury Town Meeting.
- Kickoff to Kindergarten is scheduled for Tuesday, January 30th at 7:00 p.m. This will be a remote meeting and kindergarten teachers from each elementary school will be in attendance.
- A joint transition meeting between Sudbury Public Schools and Lincoln Public Schools will be held for 8th grade Special Ed families transitioning to LSRHS on January 17th.
- Curtis and Loring Outdoor Space updates were provided.

Questions from participants included:

- Concerns regarding the Loring playground and the negative impacts on students not having access to the full structure for a significant part of the year were shared.
- Multiple parents asked questions regarding SPS guidelines for homework. Concerns about executive functioning skills, middle school readiness, and inconsistency amongst the elementary schools was also shared.

Mr. Crozier ended the meeting at 11:30 a.m.
