Updates included:

- Central Office will be closing to the public on Monday, December 11th as staff begin to transition to the new Fairbank Building. Staff will be working throughout the district during the move.
- The Curtis Wellness Space is coming along nicely. Due to the cold weather, surfacing work will be completed in the Spring.

- On January 30th at 7:00 p.m. the Student Services Department will host a transition meeting for PK - K students on IEP's. In addition, there will be a transition meeting for students moving from 8th to 9th grade on January 11th at 7:00 p.m. Both meetings will be held remotely and the links will be sent out closer to the meeting dates.
- The month of December begins the development of the FY25 Budget. There are five School Committee meetings throughout the month of December. Topics covered will include presentations on budget priorities and enrollment projections, summer programming priorities, PK school expansion, maintaining SEL support and MCAS reporting. The annual Budget Hearing will be held on Monday, December 18th.
