Superintendent's PIE Meeting Thursday, March 9, 2023 10:00 a.m. Remote Meeting

Superintendent Crozier opened the meeting at 10:01 a.m. and welcomed all who were present on Zoom.

Updates included:

- SMILE notices have gone out district wide. We have received 250 recommendations so far. A
 high percentage of staff hired are SPS educators.
- Two Educational Forums are being provided in an effort to educate the community about the
 rationale for the Override request. PTO's from each of the schools are having meetings that
 Brad will be attending. Sudbury TV will be filming the second Community Forum and will post
 the video on Sudbury TV.
- Haynes Principal Finalist site visits were conducted last week. The new Haynes Principal will be announced on Friday, March 10th.
- Brad and School Committee Chair, Silvia Nerssessian, attended a Legislative Breakfast meeting that highlighted bills that will benefit FY25 school budgets.

Questions from participants included:

- If the override doesn't pass and 7.5 positions need to be eliminated, are they spread out amongst the schools and have those positions been identified? When will the parents be notified of positions lost and class sizes.
- If the override passes in March, does it have to pass at Town Meeting as well?
- Were other options to close the override gap considered? If so, why were those options eliminated?
- A parent shared concern about how Sudbury is addressing insensitivity toward students with disabilities.
- Would the district consider making snow / delay decisions the night before impact weather is expected?

Mr. Crozier ended the meeting at 10:27 a.m.
