Remote Meeting Held on Zoom

- I. Superintendent Brad Crozier began the meeting by welcoming the community members present, passing along a few updates, and explaining the procedures for the meeting.
 1. Mr. Crozier thanked everyone who helped the District celebrate teacher and nurse appreciation week. The contributions were many and staff very much appreciated the outpouring of thanks.
 2. Superintendent Crozier informed everyone on the call that SPS has passed 20,000 individual COVID-19 tests administered.
 3. End of the year activities are now being planned. The District is working with PTOs and each school to carry out celebrations that have been adjusted to continue to meet safety guidelines.
 4. Planning continues on this summer's SMILE program. Invitations continue to be sent to families to participate. The District still awaits a passing vote at Town Meeting to fund the program.
 5. CDC guidelines in regards to COVID-19 continue to evolve. Earlier today, the CDC announced that fully vaccinated individuals need not wear a mask indoors or outdoors, but left final decision to state and local bodies. SPS will continue to require masks in all spaces.
 6. Mr. Crozier announced a change in the quarantining policy for SPS. Contact tracing will now occur for any contacts with a positive case within 6', but quarantining will only occur when contact has been made with a positive case within 3'. This will be communicated in a memo to families soon.
 7. On June 10 from 6:30-8:00, SPS will welcome a guest speaker to present on the topic of educational equity.
 8. There will soon be an official groundbreaking on the Loring Playground, the fourth new, ADA-compliant playground at the SPS elementary schools.

9. The Curriculum Team is had at work creating teacher professional development opportunities for the summer break.
