Mrs. Geronikos announced that our district was the only district that did not unanimously approve **REPORTS** the budget for LCTI. She urged board members to address any concerns they have with her.

Mr. Cox made a motion, which was seconded by Mrs. Geronikos, that the Board of Education

approves the following financial items:

Berkheimer Assoc. Del. Per Capita Tax Claims Enact resolution(s) to authorize fees associated with Berkheimer Associates for continued collection efforts regarding delinquent per-capita tax claims where liens were previously filed.

Refund of Real Estate Taxes Approve a refund in the amount of \$379.26 to Jackie C. & Kimberly S. Hankee, 1504

Fernwood Rd, Slatington. The refund is due to an assessment change as a result of fire damage for 6

months of the 2004-2005 real estate tax bill.

Extension Of Transportation Contract Approve a contract extension for student transportation with Laidlaw Education Services for the school years 2007-2008, 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 with a rate increase following the Consumer Price Index (CPI) with a minimum of 2.5% and a maximum of 3.5% annually each year of the extension. Additionally, Laidlaw will purchase and install, at their cost, video cameras and boxes in the existing fleet of vehicles. This will include the 23 current vehicles (20 current runs and 3 spare vehicles) to be equipped plus 2 future runs. Upon the completion of the 2009-2010 school year, Laidlaw will turn ownership of the video systems over to the district.

Lease Agreement for Bus Garage Bus Garage in accordance with the current student transportation agreement date April 5, 2004. This lease will run concurrent with the student transportation agreement for the school years 2007-2008, 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 and will follow the same terms as set in the April 5, 2004 agreement at the following rates:

September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2008 - \$17,390 September 1, 2008 to August 31, 2009 - \$18,000 September 1, 2009 to August 31, 2010 - \$18,540
