<u>Carbon Lehigh Intermediate Unit</u> – Mr. Bryan C. Dorshimer

Mr. Dorshimer reported from the CLIU Board Brief which was distributed to all board

He also announced that Mr. Robert Keegan was appointed to the position of Executive of the Carbon Lehigh Intermediate Unit. He will assume this role in April 2006.

<u>Lehigh Career and Technical Institute</u> – Mrs. Sheryl A. Giles was appointed as the LCTI Joint Operating Committee representative from the Board to fill the unexpired term of Mrs. Lori Geronikos until December 2007.

<u>Legislative Report</u> – Mr. Gregory S. Williams was appointed to the position of Legislative Chairperson for the Northern Lehigh Board of school directors. Mr. Williams reported on the Legislative Breakfast that he and some other board members attended.

<u>Committee Reports and/or Meetings</u> -- The Finance Committee meeting scheduled for November 28, 2005 has been postponed\_and has been rescheduled for December 7, 2005 immediately following the Technology/Buildings and Grounds Committee meeting which begins at 6:30 p.m.

Superintendent's Report - Dr. Nicholas P. Sham, Sr.

Dr. Sham discussed the new PSBA Standards for Effective School Governance and a Revised Code of Conduct for members of Pennsylvania's School Boards. He suggested that the policy be turned over to the policy committee for review.

He announced that the Weatherly District is offering a PSBA New Board Orientation Fast Track Weekend.

He distributed new PSBA New Board Member Packets and Certificates.

He announced that he received a request to go into arbitration with regard to the Act 80 Grievance that was acted upon at the last public board meeting. He announced that he also received a grievance from the Clerical Group which deals with understanding what was negotiated in their contract. A Level II hearing, with the clerical group representatives, is scheduled with the superintendent for December 13.

#### Public Comment

Robert Cox – Washington Township – It may be good to have the actual dates to make sure that everyone comes away from the meeting with a clear idea of the dates.

Attorney Stopp addressed the board. He informed them that in order to conduct business a board of nine members requires a quorum of five. It is good to have everybody in attendance because it is a very important position and also important to have as many people as possible in attendance at each meeting. The school code requires that in some very important instances that a majority of the board must be present to take action. If there is a meeting where only five board members are present, it would take all five board members to agree to take action on some very important and significant business. He suggested that the board conduct their deliberations and choose the most convenient night for the board so that there are as many elected board members in attendance at the meetings as possible.

Donna Kulp – Washington Township – Agreed with Mr. Ruth as far as the different nights for the monthly meeting.

Effective for the 2006-07 school year, the hourly rate for non-routine matters will be \$165 per hour. The rate for routine or general advice will be \$120 per hour. The current rates of \$145/\$110 will continue for the balance of this school year. The new rates will effective July 1, 2006. The current rates have remained unchanged for four years.
