- STEELS Standards & New State Science Assessment
 - Curriculum
 - 24-25 STEELS Standards must be incorporated into science curriculum
 - Classroom Diagnostic Tool (CDT)
 - 24-25 CDT will introduce new items on the science assessments that will be aligned to the STEELS standards
 - Science PSSA
 - Grade 4
 - 24-25 will transition from grade 4 to grade 5 and will be administered as a census field test. Data will be used to produce the 25-26 state test.
 - 25-26 5th grade Science PSSA will be fully aligned to the STEELS standards and used for state and federal reporting
 - Grade 8
 - 24-25 8th grade Science PSSA will be administered as a census field test. Data will be used to produce the 25-26 state test.
 - 25-26 8th grade Science PSSA will be fully aligned to the STEELS standards and used for state and federal reporting

- Biology Keystone
 - 24-25 Biology Keystone will include embedded field test items aligned to STEEL Standards that will not count towards the student's score
 - 25-26 Biology Keystone will be STEELS-aligned
