At PVS we value learner and teacher agency in our community. This means that we invite opportunities for scholars to have genuine voice, choice and ownership in their learning. Agency provides space for scholars to explore their curiosities and passions while advocating for how they can best share and demonstrate their understanding in ways that are unique to them.

Action

The aim of learning in the PYP is to empower our scholars to take action in response to their learning. Through PYP Action students develop and demonstrate the attributes of the learner profile and the PYP attitudes, integral to becoming an internationally minded learner. Action projects are voluntary, student-initiated activities that stem from a genuine concern and a desire to make a positive difference.

Exhibition

All scholars in the PVS PYP are required to complete an Exhibition Project in the final year (Grade 6) of the program. The exhibition is the culminating, collaborative experience in the final year of the IB PYP. Scholars will explore, document, and share their understanding of an issue or opportunity of personal significance. An Exhibition showcase will be scheduled for scholars to share about their projects with the community.
