SV earns spot on College Board's 2014 Advanced Placement Honor Roll

Seneca Valley is one of 547 school districts in the U.S. and Canada being honored by the College Board with placement on the 5th Annual AP® District Honor Roll for increasing access to AP course work while simultaneously maintaining or increasing the percentage of students earning scores of 3 or higher on AP Exams.

Reaching these goals indicates that the district is successfully identifying motivated, academically prepared students who are ready for the opportunity of AP. Since 2012, Seneca Valley has increased the number of students participating in AP while improving the number of students earning AP Exam scores of 3 or higher. **In 2014, 52 Seneca Valley students were recognized as AP Scholars in the program.**

Drug & Alcohol Prevention Programs at Seneca Valley are viewed locally and nationally as model programs. These services provide support and promote prevention and intervention.

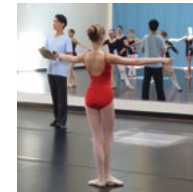
