## Unique Services



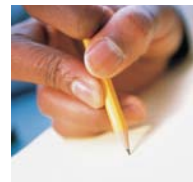
**Special services** are provided to students identified as exceptional: learning disabled, mentally disabled, seriously emotionally challenged, speech and/or language impaired, and gifted.
