K-12 UNIFORM POLICY 2024 - 2025

GENERAL INFORMATION

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS & APPEARANCE

Students are expected to be in approved uniforms daily in Cross colors of red, white, and navy blue. Appearance should be neat, modest, and orderly at all times. Collared shirts must be tucked in, socks must be worn with shoes, shoelaces tied and hair should be kept neat and clean. Navy blue bike shorts must be worn under a jumper, dress, or skirt. No cargo pants/shorts are permitted. Belts are required with shorts or pants and should be plain leather, either black or brown. A boy's hair should be kept neat and groomed to not distract from the learning process. Hair dye, colored hair extensions, or face paint are not permitted. Girls' jewelry and hair accessories should not be distracting; only studded jewelry is allowed for the nose. Boys may not wear earrings. No face piercings are allowed and tattoos may not be visible while wearing a Cross uniform/jersey.

INDOOR/OUTDOOR OUTERWEAR POLICY

When indoors, students may wear any outerwear (jacket, fleece, or hoodie) from approved uniform providers that have the approved Cross logo/graphic. Colors allowed are red, white, or navy blue. Students should have their assigned daily uniform worn underneath all outerwear.

On Chapel days, the ONLY permitted outerwear is Lands' End fleece jacket, Lands' End/Spirit Store quarter zip pullover, and Spirit Store jacket (name on back). Students should remove any non-approved jacket or pullover before entering a place of worship (The Chapel or gymnasium).

When outdoors, students are permitted to wear jackets and coats of their choice (free from excessive logos, araphics, and pictures. While not required, we do encourage outerwear to be Cross colors.

SHOE POLICY

BOY/GIRL:

Approved shoe choices included any closed toe or athletic shoe. Shoes should have no wheels, lights, skulls, or inappropriate characters/logos. No Crocs or boots.

Students choice of approved shoes may be worn with Academic Day and Chapel Day uniforms, including Spirit Day Fridays. An athletic shoe must be worn on PE days.

SOCK POLICY

BOY/GIRL: **SOLID** white, navy, or black socks to be worn. Logos should be discreet and appropriate.

GRANDFATHERED ITEMS

Uniform items in light blue, royal blue, gray, or plaid will be grandfathered in for 2024-2025.

STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COURSE

Students must be in school designated day uniform before and after strength and conditioning class.

SPIRIT DAY FRIDAYS

both GIRLS & BOYS

On Fridays, students are permitted to wear approved Spirit Wear attire.

Shirts: Cross uniform shirt

Cross Spirit Wear t-shirt in colors of white, navy or red

Spirit Wear shirts are provided through Spirit Store or by Cross Activities

(Mission shirt, Club shirts, etc.)

Bottoms: Cross uniform bottoms or PE uniform shorts

Jeans: blue or white *(no rips or holes allowed)*

NOT PERMITTED: spirit t-shirts in <u>non-Cross colors</u>

SCISA attire jeggings hats Croc shoes

VARSITY TEAMS

Varsity students are permitted to wear team jersey and approved team apparel on Fridays.

COLLEGE DAY THURSDAYS

Students in <u>UPPER SCHOOL</u> are allowed to wear a college shirt with uniform bottoms on Thursdays.

Students who choose not to wear a college shirt must be in academic uniform.

Any student and their parents will have received a <u>minimum of two "gentle reminders"</u> about the dress code policy from their teacher before the Uniform Infraction Policy procedures are put into place.

A change of inappropriate/non-dress code clothing may occur because of an infraction. This can result in a phone call to parents for an approved uniform to be brought to campus for student to change into.

3rd INFRACTION - CONSEQUENCE- Loss of Spirit Wear Day Privilege

Uniform reminder emailed. Student will need to dress in Academic Day Uniform on designated Friday per teacher or Division Head.

MIDDLE & UPPER SCHOOL

1st INFRACTION - WARNING

Uniform reminder emailed. Change of inappropriate/non-dress code clothing may occur.

2nd INFRACTION - CONSEQUENCE - Loss of Spirit Wear Day Privilege

Uniform infraction emailed. Change of inappropriate/non-dress code clothing may occur. Student will need to dress in Academic Day Uniform on designated Friday per teacher or Division Head.

3rd INFRACTION - CONSEQUENCE- Loss of Spirit Wear Day Privilege and Lunch Detention Issued

Uniform infraction emailed. Change of inappropriate/non-dress code clothing may occur. Student will need to dress in Academic Day Uniform on designated Friday per teacher or Division Head.

4TH INFRACTION - CONSEQUENCE- Loss of Spirit Wear Day Privilege and After School Detention

Uniform infraction emailed. Student will need to dress in Academic Day Uniform on designated Friday per teacher or Division Head, and be assigned **After School Detention**. Athletes or students in clubs will serve assigned detention before being allowed to participate in sports or activities on the day they are in After School Detention (coach/advisor notified). If student fails to serve the required detention within 48 hours, there will be a loss of privileges (sports, clubs, etc.) until detention is served.

SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES FOR STUDENTS WILL RESULT IN CONSEQUENCES DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

ALL UNIFORM INFRACTIONS WILL SET TO ZERO AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH SEMESTER.
