 - Mr. Kelahan reviewed the Niche.com 2017 School Ranking with the Board of Education. This ranking is based on report card data, information from the Office of Civil Rights, and surveys.
 - Mr. Kelahan discussed with the Board of Education the positive feedback received on Project Fibonacci, and the innovative work we are doing here at Oriskany.
 - Mr. Kelahan shared how we continue to work collaboratively with our partners, and are exploring the possibility of creating a Center for Innovation School.
 - Mr. Kelahan discussed the importance of developing a highly engaged workforce, and how important it is that we as a school community think innovatively.
