

## Oriskany boys win their 6th straight

**Phelps, Warcup brothers help CSC Division IV leaders improve to 11-2**

The Oriskany boys basketball team is on a roll.

Oriskany outscored Mount Markham 28-4 in the first quarter and 48-16 in the first half Wednesday night, and the Center State Conference Division IV leaders coasted to an 81-43 non-league win in a CSC crossover at Keith Davis Gymnasium.

Senior Ricky Phelps had four of Oriskany's eight 3-pointers and finished with 20 points and six assists. Mykal Warcup added 10 points and five assists, brother Aaron Warcup scored 10 points and Colt Davis had nine points and three steals.

It was the sixth straight win for Oriskany, 11-2 overall and leading the CSC Division IV standings with an 8-1 mark. Oriskany plays a league game at Remsen on Friday night, and then meets Clinton in the 10 a.m. opener of the Mohawk Valley Basketball Classic on Saturday at Utica College.

Julianna Cavanaugh scored 10 points and Sydney Lusher had 12 rebounds and seven assists for the Indians (6-1 TVL, 11-2 overall), who have won five straight games and nine of their last 10. Oneida hosts Whitesboro on Friday night. Morgan Brewer scored 11 points and Anna Rossi had 10 for the Red Devils (4-4, 7-8).

It was the sixth consecutive win for SUNY Poly, now 8-0 in the conference and 12-5 overall.
