 - a. Mr. Gaffney stated that the Embargo has been lifted.
- 4. Communications of the School Business Administrator/District Clerk
 - a. Mrs. Widman stated that for the Phase III Project we will be renewing the existing BAN in July 2019 and that a BOND will go out in June 2020.

5. Communications of the Building Principals

NA Walbran:

- a. Data Meetings are being held this week. At the meetings, Mrs. Lowell and Ms. Hinderling will discuss NYS Assessment and STAR Data with the teachers as well as reorganizing RtI groups to inform their instruction for growth.
- b. The Principal's Cabinet for Instructional Leaders met and finalized the February 15 Professional Development Early Release. They have also started drafting a schedule for the 2019-20 school year.
- c. On Friday Ms. Hinderling will be attending a Multi-Tiered System of Support and Response to Intervention PLC in Syracuse with Sue Romeo. Topics include screening for social, emotional and behavior concerns, mental health, PBIS and district examples of MTSS models.
- d. There are some exciting traditions coming up: On February 13, there will be another Book Drive. On February 14 there will be a Winter Fun Day including sledding for grades PK-4. Grade 5 is ice skating at the Whitestown Rec Center and Grade 6 is snowshoeing at Black River. February 15 is the 100 Day celebration. Activities include students visiting different classrooms to write stories with 100 words, make a 100 day book, make crowns of 100 items, etc. Also there will be daily announcements, a 100 day boot prize contest, and students are encouraged to dress like a 100 year old, like someone from 1919 or wear a shirt with 100 items and pre-kindergarten and kindergarten is collecting 100 cans for The Rescue Mission.

Jr./Sr. High School:

- a. Last Wednesday, Ms. Thompson attended the OHM BOCES Principals' Meeting. Mental Health Education was discussed. Other topics discussed were: Changes to the World Languages Exams, upcoming professional development opportunities, computer-based testing, and Student Learning Objectives (SLOs).
- b. Tomorrow morning Soldier Bill Sawyer from Fort Stanwix will present to all 7th graders 1st period in the Auditorium. During his visit he will discuss the daily life of a soldier during the Revolutionary War and then about some of the drills that the soldiers need to complete. He then has the students come down onto the floor and attempt to march to the beat of the drum that he brings with him as if they were in the army themselves.
- c. On Wednesday Ms. Thompson will attend the Winter Distance Learning Meeting at OHM BOCES with Mr. Williams. The focus of the meeting will include updates to the distance

- learning course offering and distance learning equipment, advances in online learning and BOCES support, general program awareness, and scheduling updates for 2019-2020.
- d. On Wednesday afternoon, the school counselors and Ms. Thompson will begin working with Mr. Sean Finnerty in conjunction with Clinton High School. They will be meeting with Mr. Finnerty and the principal and counselors from Clinton High School for a minimum of 8 3-hour meetings over the next few months. Mr. Finnerty will guide us through updating our Counseling Plan to improve our program and align with the new state regulations for counseling plans, which go into effect July 1, 2019.
- e. Ms. Thompson will be meeting with the Instructional Leaders tomorrow to plan for February department meetings. The focus of February department meetings will be to discuss faculty expectations for our classroom visitations to other schools on March 14th. This discussion will help the Instructional Leaders work together to create a debrief form from these classroom visitations.
