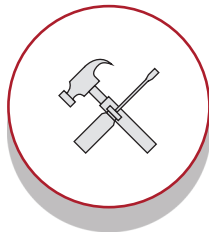
REFERENDUM VOTE

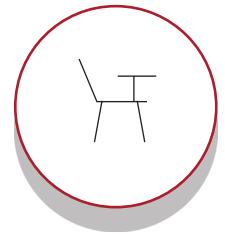
