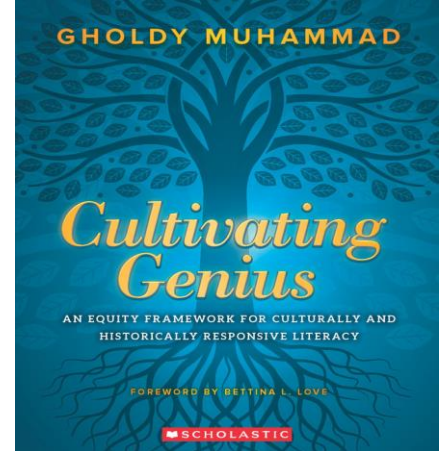
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Shifting Cultural Norms

Equity Framework for Culturally and Historically Responsive Literacy

- Identity:** How does what students are learning help develop their identity and create meaningful connections to their lives?
- Skills:** How are standards met and demonstrated by all students?
- Intellect:** What cognitive and adaptive application skills are students developing?
- Criticality:** How does this learning support students in identifying and taking agency towards ending oppressive systems?
- Joy:** What brings joy and satisfaction to student's learning experiences and personal lives?
