

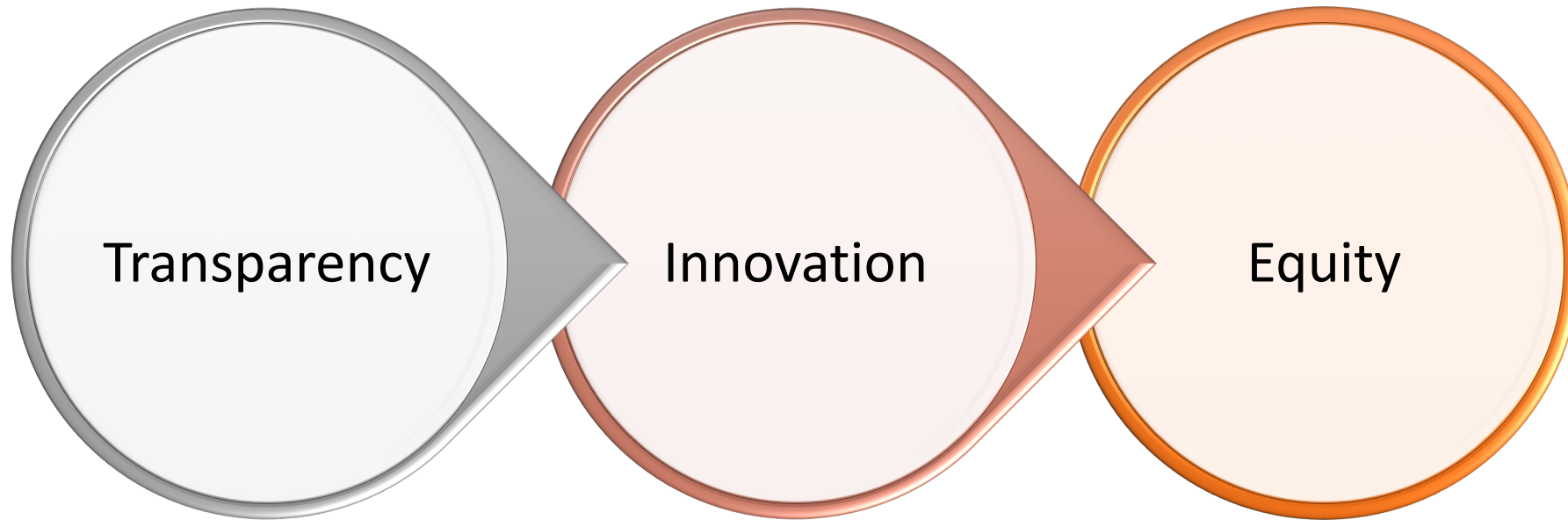

Transparency in Pittsburgh Public Schools

Theme 1, Initiative 1a

Establish high-functioning Student Assistance Program teams in every school that follow the Multi-Tiered System of Support Process



- Provided professional development to administrators on prevention vs intervention using the MTSS process
- Provided resource matrices in ELA and mathematics to ensure appropriate use of resources
- Provided behavior matrix to support both prevention and intervention (includes PBIS and Restorative Practices)

Theme 2, Initiative 1b

Develop a comprehensive assessment system aligned to grade-level expectations

- Purchase of instructional materials in ELA and mathematics, additional resources in Biology
- Revise curriculum to reflect new instructional materials and full alignment to PA Core Standards
- Revise assessments to align with PA Core Standards

Transparency in Pittsburgh Public Schools

Theme 3, Initiative 1b

Align instructional support efforts to ensure a collaboration between school administrators and district staff around the school's professional development focus

- Release professional development days to allow schools an opportunity to provide differentiated training based on schools' needs.
- Empower leadership teams through: during the Summer Leadership Academy and Essential Practice training to support school improvement planning.
- increase course offerings for professional learning, new teacher training, ongoing job-embedded professional development through active coaching support in the classroom, building level support

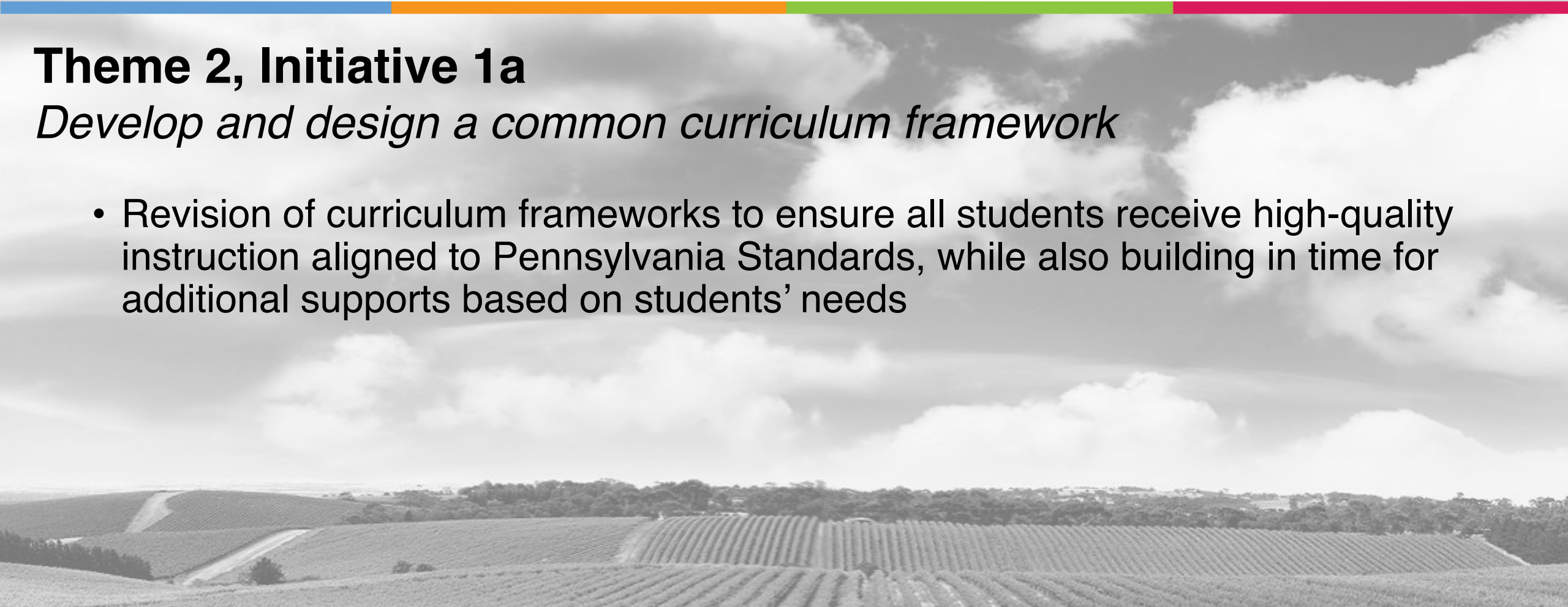

- Revision of curriculum frameworks to ensure all students receive high-quality instruction aligned to Pennsylvania Standards, while also building in time for additional supports based on students' needs

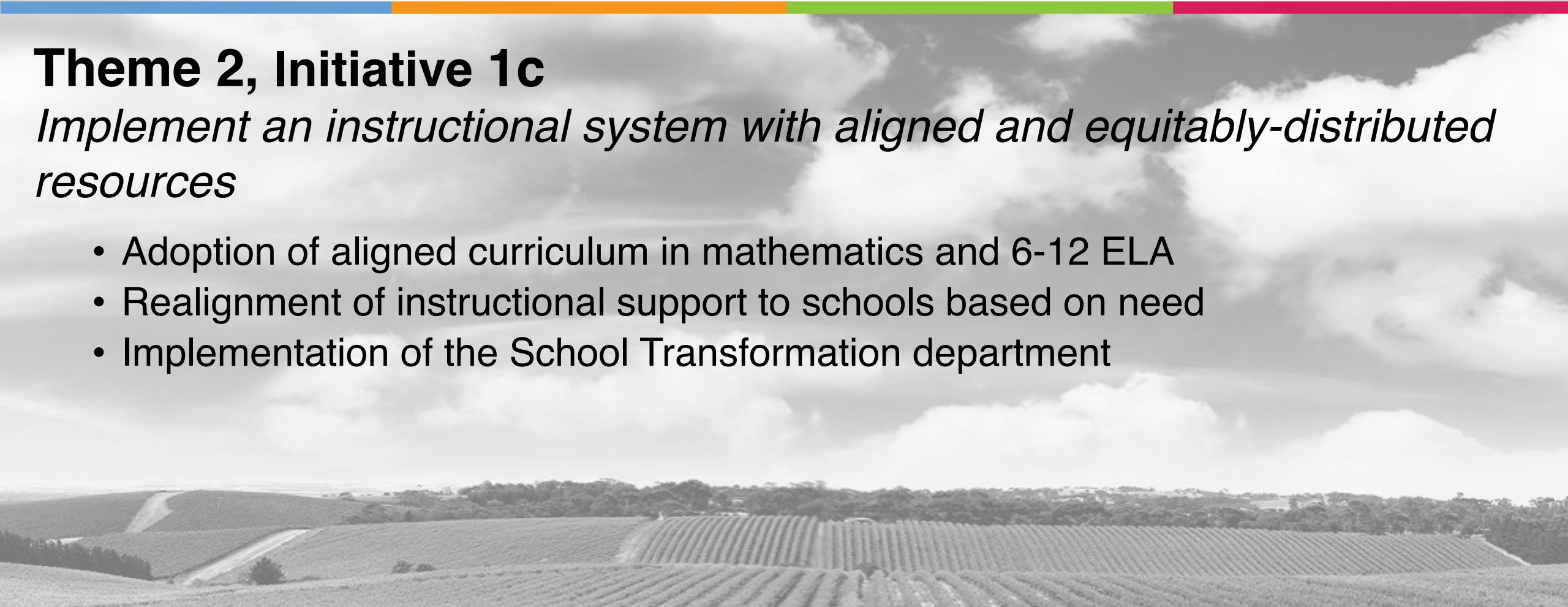


Equity in Pittsburgh Public Schools

- Empower PPS Youth Participatory Budget Council to serve as advocates in the community

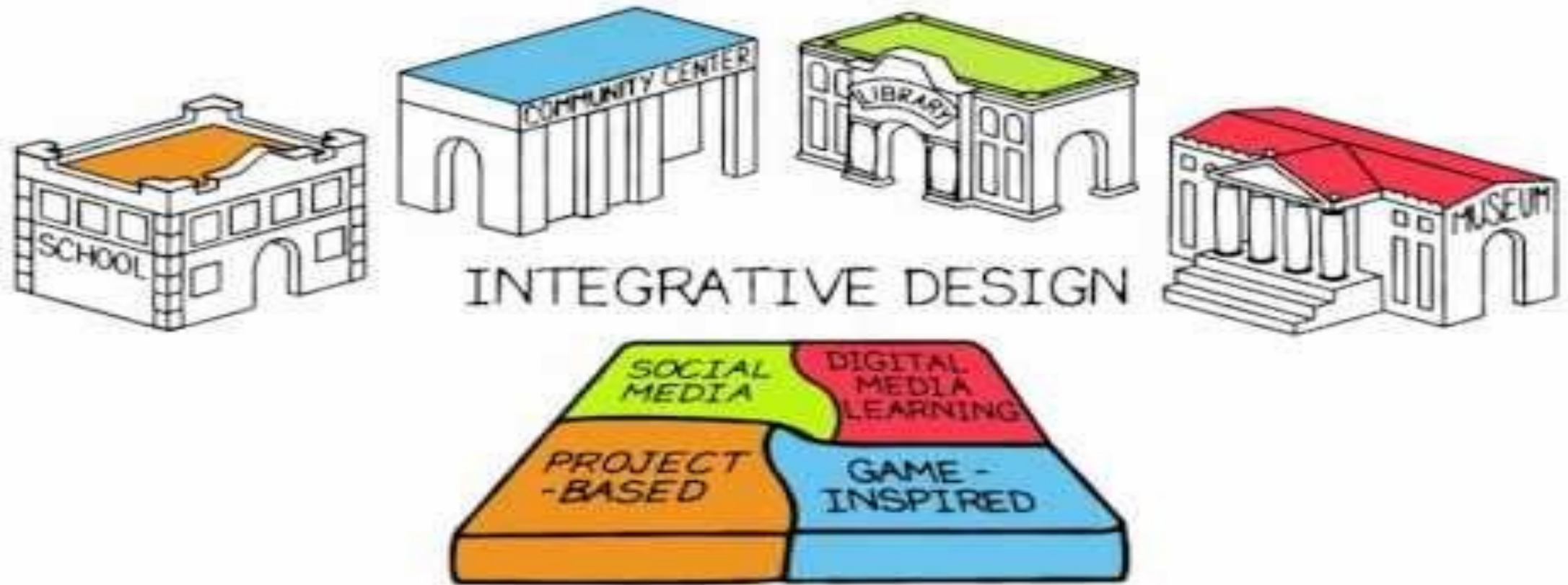
