





- It was asked if teachers could go over the ESS Survey Questions prior to giving it out to ensure that students comprehend the questions being asked.
 - **-Larmond** responded that she has a Principal meeting coming up and that she would ask if this would be ok to do.
- Ms. James asked if we have Junior Achievement students presenting to Bethesda students. She feels it would be helpful for our 3rd-5th students to understand when making choices for careers.
 - **-Larmond** responded no but that we can look into it. We do have College Panels every year where we have college students speak to our 3rd-5th graders about their experiences and why they selected the degree they chose. We also had the Construction Academy. They showed our students how to use tools for construction. We are looking into partnering with the High School now that we have more performing arts and the kids with film studio to do more projects together. Our PTA already got in touch with the Construction Academy to have some work done at our school and get some volunteer hours out of it.
- Ms. Rojo mentioned that Maxwell has programs that we could partner with in the future.
 -Larmond: I am trying to get our students to make connections with the outside world when it comes to the EL modules. For example, the weather unit in kindergarten and how our students do the weather every morning. We could have some of our Kindergartens make the announcements and do the weather.

Having the weather truck come in so that our students can make those connections with what they are learning in the classrooms to the real world. The more we learn about this curriculum, the more we can plan and bring outside connections to what they are learning.

- Ms. Rojo asked if there was any data that compares our school to any other DLI schools.
 -Larmond- At this time the county hasn't given us any data, but I can check into that.
 GCPS DLI schools have different populations of students.
- Ms. Marin was concerned about inviting non-English-speaking parents to come to the meeting. Ms. Larmond let everyone known that we are trying to purchase additional Jarvison devices to make it easy for parents to get the English translation.
