

Student Success and Wellness Funds Plan

- Mental Health Services partner with Westwood Behavioral to provide social workers (mental health specialists) within Lincolnview Local Schools serving K-12 students.
- Western Buckeye ESC to provide school psychologists to also provide special education and mental health services to students of Lincolnview Local Schools (K-12).
- Lincolnview Local Schools also will be partnering with Van Wert Ohio Health (local hospital) to provide nursing services (full-time) for all K-12 students.
- Lincolnview Local Schools have also contracted with Cintas, a regional company, to provide Automated External Defibrillators (AED's), first aid kits, and instructional manuals to all staff members within the district.
- The Lincolnview Local Schools also partnered with Nationwide Children's hospital to provided educational materials on student health initiatives.
- The Lincolnview Local Schools planned and initiated multiple educational learning nights throughout the school year for families and students to engage in learning skills.
