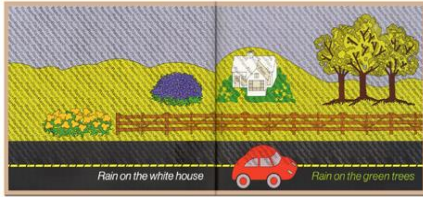


Unit 1, Week 6 Choice Board



Read Aloud

After listening to the story, work together to find one item in your house or outside for each color: blue, gray, white, yellow, green, red, black, pink, and purple.

Subitize

Show your child a set of coins between 1 and 5. Give your child 2 seconds to look at the set before covering the set. Ask your child to tell you how many they saw.

This is like taking a picture with your eyes.

Read Aloud

Gather objects such as coffee stirrers, chenille sticks, popsicle sticks, pencils, pieces of yarn (for letters that have curves), etc. Show your child the materials and tell them they are going to build letters! Support your child as they learn to recognize letters and link the sounds to the letters, as you work together to build letters of the alphabet.

Write M and A on two separate pieces of paper. As you say a word that begins with M or A, ask your child to hold up the letter for the sound they hear at the beginning of each word. Repeat with several words that begin with each sound, (apple, mask, monkey, ankle, astronaut, moon, ambulance, mountain). After the game, ask your child to "rainbow trace" each letter with several different colored markers or crayons.
