Freight Train



After watching the read aloud, discuss different types of transportation, (e.g., airplane, car, boat, train, bicycle), and ask:

- 1.) Which one would help us get somewhere the fastest and why?
- 2.) Which one would they like to ride and where would they go? Then, ask them to draw a picture of what they described.

Keep Counting

Practice counting by rolling a ball backand-forth and counting aloud. As each person receives the ball, they say the number that comes next. This supports a child's ability to count forward from a number other than one.



Math Magic

Create a number line by writing numerals 0-10, from left to right, on a piece of paper. Cover all but one number and play "math magic" by asking your child to identify what number comes before or after the number that is not covered. If the numeral 3 is uncovered and your child says, "4 comes after 3," ask them how they know. Then, uncover 4, and continue by asking what comes before 3 or after 4. Continue playing until all numerals are uncovered. This activity supports children's understanding of number order.



Beginning Sound Bag

Needed for this activity:

- 1.) Put several items around the house in a bag, (e.g., pencil, fork, marker, sock, book, ring, dime).
- 2.) Write the first letter of each item on separate pieces of paper.

As your child pulls an item from the bag, name the item, and ask them what sound they hear at the beginning of that word. Then, ask them if they can identify and hold up the paper that has that letter written on it

Wemberly Worried

After watching the read aloud, ask your child:

- 1.) Who was in the story?
- 2.) What happened at the beginning?
- 3.) What was happening in the middle of the story?
- 4.) What happened at the end of the story?
- 5.) Have you ever felt worried?

<u>Challenge:</u> Ask your child to draw a picture of what could help them feel better if they ever feel worried and then describe their drawing to you.
