Subitize

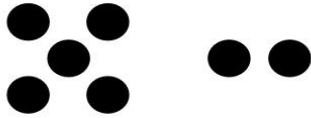

My Alphabet Book

Make 1 page for each letter A-F. Practice writing that letter and draw pictures or cut pictures from magazines of things that begin with that letter.



Matching Numerals to Quantities

Write numerals to 0-10 on separate pieces of paper, then make dot cards like the one above, on separate pieces of paper, to match with each numeral. Help your child match the correct numeral to the correct set of dots.

Pass Me the Rhyme Activity:
