

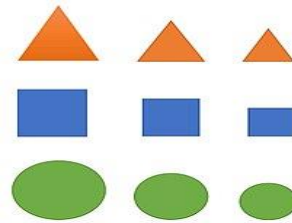
Unit 4, Week 2 Choice Board

Emotions Charades

Review the meaning of the following emotions: happy, sad, lonely, angry, scared, frustrated, disappointed, worried, proud. Take turns with your child acting out one of the emotions, while the other person tries to guess the emotion. Once identified, each should describe what makes them feel: happy, sad, frustrated, etc., and what they can do when they feel a negative emotion to make them feel better.

Play "I Spy"

Have your child hunt to find objects with matching beginning sounds. Hold an object in your hand, like a ball. Tell them "I spy something in my hand that starts with the /b/ /b/ /b/ sound. What else makes the /b/ sound? (bowl, brush, boat, Barbie, etc.).

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
