Read Aloud

Link: Harold's Fairy Tale



After listening to the story, ask your child to tell you who the main character is in this story, retell what happened, and whether this story was real or imaginary. Then, ask your child to create their own drawing and describe each part of what they have drawn. Encourage them to add details, such as the sun, grass, a tree, flowers, etc. As they name each part of their picture, help them identify the beginning and ending sound of each word and help them write the letter for each sound to label their drawing.

Number Movement Activity

Write numerals 0-10 on separate pieces of paper. As you hold up each number, ask your child what number they see on the paper, then ask them to jump that many times with you.

Help your child draw a "blueprint" of something they would like to build. Ask them to describe what they have drawn. As they name each part, ask them to identify the beginning and ending sound of each word and help them label their drawing.
