1. For the 2015-16 school year, all per diem substitute teachers shall be paid at the rate of \$85 per day. In the event that the per diem substitute teacher works more than ten (10) consecutive days in the same assignment, the rate of pay shall increase to \$95 per day. These rates of pay shall be prorated if the per diem substitute teacher works less than a full day.

2. In the event that the District hires a substitute teacher for an assignment that is anticipated by the District to be less than a full semester, the substitute teacher shall be deemed a per diem substitute teacher and paid in accordance with paragraph 1, above. In the event that the assignment exceeds 30 days and the substitute teacher will continue in the same assignment, the substitute teacher shall be deemed a long-term substitute teacher and paid in accordance with paragraph 3, below.

3. In the event that the District hires a substitute teacher for an assignment that is anticipated by the District to last a full semester or more, the substitute teacher shall be deemed a long-term substitute teacher and shall be paid at the per diem rate of $1/200^{\text{th}}$ of a Step 1 teacher salary with no additional benefits.
