Call to Order

Dr. Brink called the meeting to order and asked for a roll call of the members.

Roll Call

Committee members Ron Humphries and Ben Howes were present, along with board members Jayson Baker (5:32) and John Lawson.

Public Participation

No one from the public was present.

Dr. Brink discussed facets of the curriculum. The topics addressed were:

1. E-Learning Plan

Members discussed the plan and updates regarding assigned times for face-to-face instruction for grades 3-8. K-2 remained email and packets.
