

### **Operating Referendum**

Voters of the District voted on November 5, 2019 to approve an Operating Levy Referendum for \$460.00 per pupil unit. This new referendum will be effective for taxes payable in 2020 for school revenue for the 2020-2021. The length of the operating referendum is 10 years and includes inflationary language.
