Medina CSD Capital Project 2023 - 2026

History

- After the completion of the 2017 Capital Project, there were several items outstanding that were not able to be completed in that project.
- A Building Conditions Survey (BCS) was conducted
- Community, faculty and staff concerns/desires
- The first list of "wants / needs" topped \$80,000,000 needed to get to less then \$35,000,000
- The intent was to create a project that would be TAX NEUTRAL
- Medina will receive almost 98% State Aid and will use reserves to fund the local share

Categories of Work

- Safety
 - Secure entrances at all buildings
- Traffic Flow
 - Improved traffic / parking throughout the district
- Program
 - Music Suite
 - Reconfiguring Junior Senior High
- Repair
 - Pool Repairs
 - Roof Repairs
 - Window Repairs

Professional Guidance

- Guidance and expertise of architects, engineers and construction managers
- Our architect, Michael Noga, has been with the district since 2002.
- Campus Construction Management successfully managed our 2017 Capital Project
- Financial advisors at Fiscal Advisors and the NYS Education Department have helped to maximize our aid
- All parties have been meeting since March 2022 to identify potential building and site work
- Once we developed a conceptual scope, estimated cost for the project was completed
- Decisions were made to provide as much scope as possible, while remaining tax neutral

Does this project address all of the district's needs?

- No, but based on input from our stakeholders and our Owner-Architect-Construction Manager (OACM) team, we have worked to prioritize our needs.
- Not everyone's needs / desires will be addressed, and work that was not completed in this project will be prioritized in the next capital project.

Concept to Reality

- We are working with a concept of work to be done
- Campus has provided an idea of what work we can do and the cost
- Community will vote on the funds to support this concept on February 14, 2023
- Once approved, the OACM will work with faculty, staff and stakeholders to "fine tune" the concept and develop final plans that will be submitted to the NYS Education Department. (Target: Fall 2023 submission)
- After approval from SED, competitive bidding for the work will be completed and awarded.
- Construction to start in Spring 2024.
- Construction to be completed in early 2026.




Campus Wide Improvements

- New technology wood shop with new dust collection system




- Reconstruct entrance vestibule and main office to improve security

- Reconstruct entrance vestibule and main office to improve security
- New District Office in former Media Center
- Reconstruction of locker rooms to provide ADA toilets near cafeteria
- New Media Center
- New Computer Lab
- Reconstruction of select mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems

Financing the Project

- Prior fiscal planning has put the district in a very favorable position
 - Capital Reserve: \$2,750,000
 - Retiring Debt: \$1,712,064
 - State Building Aid: \$29,895,213
- State Aid
 - ▶ 98% Aid ratio comes back to the district after completion
- Net cost impact
 - District's share will be offset by the Reserve Spending
- NO IMPACT ON THE TAX LEVY!
