1. Choose a country.
2. Research and find the following information:
 - color picture of flag (5 pts)
 - three famous landmarks/monuments one might visit there (5 pts each)
 - one famous person from the country (5pts)
 - language(s) spoken **AND** how to say "welcome" (5 pts **each**)
 - map with capital city highlighted (5 pts **each**)
3. Cut out construction paper in the shape of a suitcase (5 pts)
4. Arrange this information in a creative way so the countries' name is dominant. (10 pts)
5. Complete the "traveler's" poster individually in class, adhering to the guidelines . Paper will be provided. Poster should be neat, colorful, and display effort. (40 pts)
