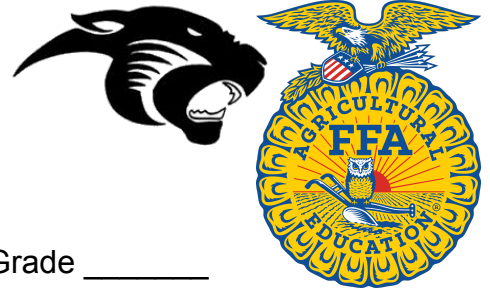


2023-2024 Glencoe-Silver Lake FFA Membership Form
