Veterans Diploma Project Honors San Bernardino County Army Veteran



As part of Operation Recognition: Veterans Diploma Project, County Schools and the San Bernardino County Department of Veterans' Services award high school diplomas to veterans who were unable to complete high school because of service to our country.

On Jan. 13, United States Army Veteran James Kiyabu was awarded a high school diploma posthumously during a special ceremony. His son, Randy,

accepted the honor on his father's behalf, and several family members were in attendance.

The Kiyabu family described the ceremony as bittersweet and added if he were present, he would have tears in his eyes. It was the elder Kiyabu's dying wish to receive a high school diploma, and his family had promised they would follow through with his request.

Since the program's inception, nearly 300 diplomas have been presented to veterans who did not complete high school due to military service during World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War or due to internment in WWII Japanese-American relocation camps.

To qualify, the applicants must be residents of San Bernardino County and service members must have been honorably discharged.
