

VPK (Optional) Supply List 2024-2025

Requested – NOT REQUIRED

Uniforms are not required for VPK, but they are greatly appreciated.

Please bring the following items to Parent Open House or Pre-K Open House. Please put the items in a grocery bag (paper or plastic) labeled with your child's name.

- Non-returnable picture of your child
- 4 large pencils (can be found at Office Depot)
- 2 24-packs of Crayola brand crayons
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors (Blunt)
- 1 small plastic box to store pencils, crayons, and scissors (without dividers)
- 10 Elmer's glue sticks (disappearing purple)
- 1 package of wrapped candy for treasures
- Complete change of clothing in a Zip-lock bag labeled with child's name (Please include socks and undergarments.)
- 1 package colored cardstock (no heavier than 67#)
- 1 package white cardstock (no heavier than 67#)

- Backpack (not small)
- 2 thin yellow highlighters
- Small whiteboard (label with child's name)

- Optional - Little toy treasures your child doesn't play with anymore: i.e. little planes, cars, animals, plastic bracelets, fun erasers, etc. (for our Toy Treasures)
