District-Wide Asbestos Program

The District will comply with the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), dated October 30, 1982, and all of its amendments, alterations, and changes. The Board supports the purpose of the Act, which is to assure that all asbestos-containing materials are identified in every school building and that such materials be maintained in non-hazardous condition until the materials are eventually removed.

In compliance with AHERA, the District has prepared a notebook that includes a Building Inspection Report and an Asbestos Management Plan for each building in the District. The notebook, which is regularly updated, is available to the public during normal working hours, and the materials are regularly updated.
